Itinerary

01-02 After arrival in JoBurg from Frankfurt strait to Riedvlei a reserve to see Banded Martin. After that the the lodge in Zaagkuildrift and birded on Crake Road see: http://wiki.sabirding.co.za/Portal.aspx?Page=Zaagkuildrift&AspxAutoDetectCookieSuppo rt=1

02-02 Drove to Nylsvlei and birded there in the morning, after that to Kgomo Kgomo and Zaagkuildrift.

03-02 Birded all day at Kgomo Kgomo and Zaagkuildrift.

04-02 Birded in the morning at Kgomo Kgomo and Zaagkuildrift in the morning and at Zonderwater wetland near Cullinan for Red-Chested Flufftail.

05-02 Birded at Kgomo Kgomo in the morning and then flew to Harare, Zimbabwe in the afternoon.

06+07 and the morning of 08-02 Birded at Monavale Vlei (several times), Marlborough Vlei and Haka Reserve in Zimbabwe, for Striped Crake and found it on the last morning. 08-02 in the afternoon flew back to Frankfurt via JoBurg.
